

# EPT DESIGN

**EPTDESIGN**, a private landscape architecture, urban design, and planning firm, is providing two paid summer landscape architecture internships to give students experience practicing landscape architecture and to assist us in our studios. We will be selecting two interns, one based in our Irvine Studio and one based in our Pasadena Studio. These internships are available for undergraduate and graduate students who will be returning to school in the fall of 2011.

Activities of the Landscape Architecture Intern may include:

- Drawing, creating design presentations, conducting research, CAD (Computer Aided Drafting), planting design, cost estimating and participating in design charrettes to gain “real world” experience in concept design, sustainable design, design development and construction documentation.
- Collecting photographs and graphics of finished projects for marketing purposes, to gain insight on the marketing processes of a private firm.
- Accompanying principals or associates on field visits to observe and document the construction progress of our current projects.
- Photographing projects and plants to be included in our image library and/or Case Study database.

We would like to offer the opportunity to gain experience at a reputable firm with a nearly 50-year history in Southern California. The interns will be working primarily in the studio of their internship, but will occasionally travel to the other studio for collaboration and presentations. Candidates should live in the area, or have pre-arranged accommodations, as there is no living or travel allowance available. Interns will work 20-40 hours per week, to be arranged upon selection. Candidates may need occasional access to a vehicle for field research within the Los Angeles basin.

Interested students should send the following items by March 31<sup>st</sup>:

1. Current resume, with contact information
2. Statement of interest: 1-page letter describing your interest in the **EPTDESIGN** internship and if there is a preferred studio for internship (Pasadena or Irvine)
3. Examples of graphic and/or written work, not to exceed 10 pages
4. Send entire package digitally, in pdf format, not to exceed 20 mb
