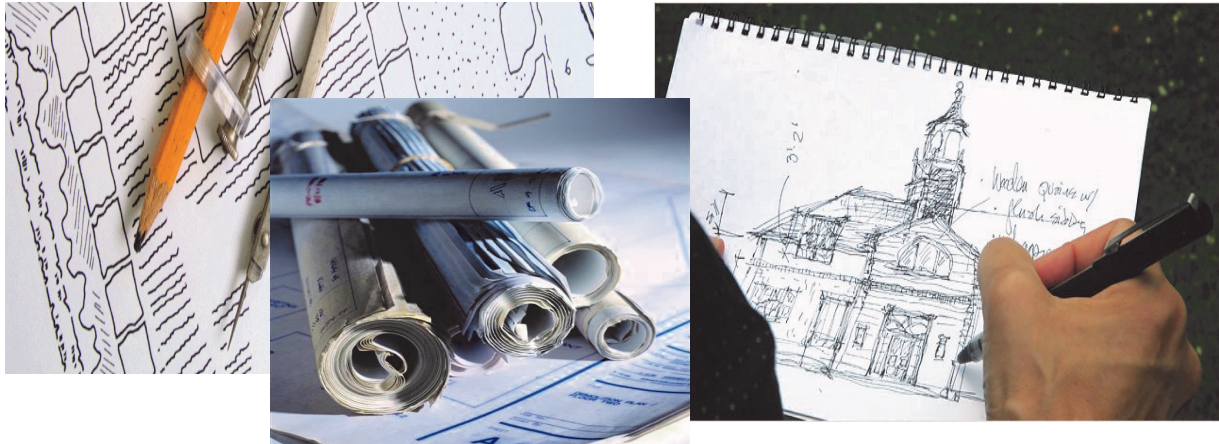

Designed for students who are preparing to take the LARE Section A: Legal and Administrative Aspects of Practice, this workshop reviews the knowledge and skills associated with regulations, contracts, and construction administration processes.

Section B

Designed for students who are preparing to take the LARE Section B: Analytical Aspects of Practice, this workshop covers the knowledge and skills related to inventory, data gathering, analysis, programming, regional land use planning, site land use planning, and principles of design.

Section D

Designed for students who are preparing to take the LARE Section D: Structural Considerations and Materials and Methods of Construction, this workshop reviews the principles and skills portion of the LARE necessary for the areas covered in Section D, including appropriate size, shape, form, technical considerations, structural considerations, materials and methods, processes of construction, construction detailing, and post-construction evaluation for compliance.
